

Mental Health Practitioner

Clients attend program between 8:00 am and 2:30 pm, therapist hours are between 7:30 am and 4:30 pm, M-F. Summer program hours vary.

Responsibilities Include:

- Provide individual and group therapy to clients.
- Facilitate and/or co-facilitate group therapy sessions and other therapeutic activities
- Perform proper use de-escalation and restraining techniques for children and adolescents in unsafe situations.
- Develop and monitor individual treatment plans for clients.
- Participate in intake assessments, conferences, IEP due process meetings, reviews, and discharge planning.
- Develop specific intervention for each client's mental health needs.
- Accurately document all communication relative to client.
- Complete case notes daily.
- Complete weekly dictation summarizing client's participation level.
- Write monthly progress notes and monthly case consults.
- Attend and participate in team meetings and clinical consults

Minimum Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree in behavioral sciences and 2000 hours of supervised experience in the delivery of mental health services to children and adolescents; OR Master's degree in behavioral sciences or related field.
- Experience in working with SED children and their families in both individual and group therapy. Experience with children ages 10-14 preferred.
- **Preferred candidates are licensure-track clinical trainees.**
